



The Academic Libraries of Indiana's Board of Directors approved a one-time contribution of \$3,000 to the *Stanford Encyclopedia of Philosophy Project* at their meeting March 28, 2006 held at Notre Dame University's Hesburgh Library, Notre Dame, IN.

These funds will go toward a maximum \$500,000 matching grant from the National Endowment for the Humanities (NEH) that earns a \$1 match from the NEH for every \$3 contributed from libraries and affiliated institutions.

In discussion, Board members commented that the Stanford Encyclopedia of Philosophy is a very significant publication with open access to its content via the World Wide Web. The publication utilizes advanced digital technology and is peer reviewed. Through contributions, the *Stanford Encyclopedia of Philosophy* can continue to remain freely available to everyone with Internet access.

In support of this important project, Indiana University Libraries sponsors a special membership organization, the [*Stanford Encyclopedia of Philosophy International Association*](#) (SEPIA), for the purpose of collecting membership dues that are eligible for matching funds from NEH.
